Board elections will be held; we welcome nominations for our five open seats.

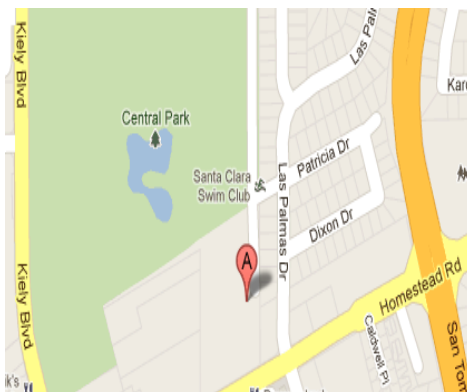

The annual meeting will include the presentation of the Don Edwards Award to Judge LaDoris Cordell (Ret.), San Jose’s Independent Police Auditor. ACLU-SCV presents the award to a local leader who has done significant work in the last year to advance civil liberties in the Santa Clara Valley and beyond. The award is named for former Bay Area Congressman Don Edwards, who was a leading civil rights advocate during his 33 years in Congress.

Hon. LaDoris Hazzard Cordell became the first African-American female judge in Northern California in 1982. She served on the Santa Clara County Municipal Court from 1982 to 1988, and on the Santa Clara County Superior Court from 1988 to 2001. From 2001 until 2009, Judge Cordell held the position of Special Counselor to the President for Campus Relations at Stanford University, where she had earned her JD in 1974. She also served on the Palo Alto City Council from 2003 to 2007.

Over the course of her distinguished career, she has received many honors for her contributions to civil rights and to the local community, including the Santa Clara County Trial Lawyers Association's "Judge of the Year" award and the Silicon Valley NAACP's Freedom Fighter Award.

Since May 2010, Judge Cordell has served as San Jose's Independent Police Auditor. According to the San Jose Mercury News, she has "set the gold standard for this office, raising the bar for professionalism, community outreach, transparency and innovation."
